Biographical Note on the Speaker

Lukas Staffler holds a Ph.D. from the University of Innsbruck (Austria) and a doctorate from the University of Padova (Italy). From 2013 to 2015, he worked at the University of Innsbruck as an assistant professor (*Universitätsassistent*) of comparative criminal law and is currently in his second year as a law trainee (*praticante avvocato*) in Bolzano (Italy). His main research fields are corporate criminal law and counterterrorism from a comparative perspective. He has published a monography and thirteen articles in the past three years.

Short Info on the Topic

In response to the terrorist attacks on Charlie Hebdo in Paris in January 2015, the Italian government initiated a reform of the criminal laws against terrorism. On 18 February 2015 already, the government finalized the legislative package and it was implemented with modifications as law on April 17, 2015. The main focus of this legislative reform was to contain the phenomenon of “foreign fighters,” so-called passive recruiting, self-education in terrorist activities, and departure for terrorist purposes. The lecturer will give an overview of the reform’s innovations to Italian Criminal Law and Criminal Procedure, illustrating its legal novelty in the context of recent Italian and the German criminal legislation against terrorism.
